RULES GOVERNING KENNETH S. WYNKIE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR'S AWARD

This award is presented annual to the most outstanding Key Club Member in the District. Members of the District Board of Trustees are not eligible for this award. This award Is in memory of the late Mr. Kenneth S. Wynkie, who served as Key Club's District Administrator from 1967 until his death in 1974. This award is presented at the District Convention.

1. Each Key Club, in good standing with the Eastern Canada District of Key Club International, may nominate only one member from their club.
2. The attached entry form should be completed and mailed to:

3. You should attach the following to the form:
 - A. Reasons why the candidate's name has been put forth, including activities over the past year, co-operation, leadership, willingness to work, participation, and general contribution to Key Clubbing (written by the Club Directors or someone other than the candidate)
 - B. Remarks and endorsement from either, the President or Chairman of the Key Club Committee of your sponsoring Kiwanis Club.
 - C. Remarks and endorsement letter from either, your school principal or his/her designated representative.
4. The District Administrator shall select the recipient of this award. The decision is final.
5. In the event that the recipient cannot attend the convention, suitable arrangements will be made for the presentation of the award at a later date in the recipient's hometown.
