Convention Covid Release and Information Form

Due to public health mandates across Canada and for the safety and wellbeing of all attendees of our District Convention, it is required that all participants have received their second vaccination in accordance with the Public Health Guidelines standardized across the country, and are readily available to present their vaccination status at the entry of the convention, as well as throughout its duration.

To ensure the good health of all attendees, each individual will be subject to the completion of the following tasks throughout the convention:

1. Present proof of their second vaccination upon entry of the convention and be readily available to present proof on their person throughout the convention.
2. Comply to the completion of temperature checks throughout the convention. Attendees must exhibit a temperature of below 38 degrees celsius.
3. Isolate if exhibiting any symptoms associated with Covid-19. Reference will be made to the most recent symptom list as provided by local Public Health Authorities.
4. Ensuring a facial covering is worn at all times over the nose and under the chin during the convention unless otherwise specified.
5. Participants are unable to attend the convention if they are pending a negative covid test result. Upon pending a test result, attendees are not permitted to be on the premises.

During DELC 2022, you will be expected to share a room with one other same-gender-identifying Key Club member. You will be assigned randomly to a room with another member from your home club. This room will then become your cohort. Mixing cohorts by switching or entering others' rooms, especially unmasked, will result in being held accountable to the full extent of the code of conduct.

Prior to the convention, if the District Board and associated staff rule that it is unsafe to follow through with the District Convention as planned for any reason, the event will move to a Virtual Platform.

As such, all registered attendees will be subject to a partial refund but be expected to attend and pay the virtual event cost. If the attendee is unable to attend the Virtual event for any reason, they will not be subject to a complete refund.

In the event of new or worsening COVID restrictions and limitations on gathering sizes, we will operate on a first come first serve basis, in where the applicable registrants to fit the gathering size will be able to attend, and all others past the cutoff will be refunded in full and not be able to attend the event.
