- Three (3) letters supporting the nominee, preferably from the Club President, Faculty Advisor, and Divisional Lieutenant-Governor, may accompany your club's nomination. No additional letters will be considered.
- The Key Club District Board shall select the recipient of this award from the nominations received. Their decision shall be final.

The winning Key Clubber will be recognized during District Convention.
