Kenneth S. Wynkie Outstanding Key Clubber Award

This award was created in memory of the late Mr. Kenneth S. Wynkie, who served as the Eastern Canada District Key Club's District Administrator from 1967 until his death in 1974. It is presented annually to the most outstanding Key Club member in the Eastern Canada District. The award will be presented at this year's District Convention.

Criteria for the Outstanding Key Clubber Award

1. Each Key Club, who is in good standing with the Eastern Canada District of Key Club International, may nominate only one (1) member from their respective club.
2. The Key Clubber cannot be an executive officer.
3. The following form must be filled out and emailed to governor@keyclub.ca AND deborahanneknight@gmail.com The following must be attached with the form:
 - Reasons why the nominee's name has been put forth, including: Activities over the past year, Co-operation within the club, Leadership, Willingness to work, Participation, General contribution to Key Club.
 - Remarks/endorsement letter from either the school principle or Faculty Advisor.

The District Administrator and District Governor will select the recipient of this award. This decision is FINAL. In the event that the recipient cannot attend convention, suitable arrangements will be made for the presentation of the award at a later date in the recipient's hometown. All nominations must be emailed no later than March 15, 2020. Any nomination postmarked or emailed after this date will not be considered for the award. Please note that the nomination must be written by a Key Club executive or general member. This nomination may not be submitted or written by the nominated Key Clubber.
